- 1. This form is to be distributed by your designated subcontractor COVID-19 onsite representative and completed by all subcontractor employees upon initial arrival to the jobsite.
- 2. Once completed, please scan or photograph the form and email to Erland's COVID-19 Officer.
- 3. The designated subcontractor COVID-19 onsite representative is to ask each of their employees at the morning meeting each day, prior to the commencement of work, if their self-certification status has changed.
- 4. The designated subcontractor COVID-19 onsite representative must deny project access to any of their employees unable to self-ceritfy and notify Erland's COVID-19 Officer immediately.
- 5. The designated subcontractor COVID-19 representative must inform Erland's COVID-19 Officer each morning that all of their employees have self-certified, even if the status of these items remains unchanged.

BY SIGNING BELOW, I CERTIFY TO THE FOLLOWING:

Within the past 24 hours, I have had no signs of any combination of the following:

- a fever or a measured temperature of 100.3 degrees F or higher
- a cough or sore throat
- shortness of breath

In the past 14 days, I have not had <u>"close contact"</u> with an individual that has traveled to any of the CDC's designated Level 3 Hot Spots. "Close contact" means:

- living in the same household as a person who has traveled to a Level 3 Hot Spot
- caring for a person who has traveled to a Level 3 Hot Spot
- for 15 minutes being within 6 feet of a person who has traveled to a Level 3 Hot Spot

* coming in contact with secretions (e.g., sharing utensils, being coughed on) from a person who has traveled to a Level 3 Hot Spot

In the past 14 days, I have not had <u>"close contact"</u> with an individual currently being tested for COVID-19 or has been advised by a medical professional to self-quarantine. "Close contact" means:

- living in the same household as a person who is being tested/self-quarantining
- caring for a person who is being tested/self-quarantining
- being within 6 feet of a person who is being tested/self-quarantining for about 15 minutes
- * coming in contact with secretions (e.g., sharing utensils, being coughed on) from a person who is being tested/self-quarantining while that person was symptomatic

In the past 14 days, I have not had <u>"close contact"</u> with an individual diagnosed with COVID-19. "Close contact" means:

- living in the same household as a person who has tested positive for COVID-19
- caring for a person who has tested positive for COVID-19
- being within 6 feet of a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 for about 15 minutes
- * coming in contact with secretions (e.g., sharing utensils, being coughed on) from a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 while that person was symptomatic

I have not been asked to self-isolate or quarantine by my doctor or any local health official.

I consent to having my temperature taken upon entry to the jobsite each day, if available, and for that information to be shared in accordance with EEOC and HIPPA regulations.

I certify that I have no medical issues that would prevent me from wearing a face mask (N-95 or equal) if it is required for the safe execution of my work.
